
Teacher Instructions for Inside/Outside Circle Activity



Directions:

- 1. Prior to activity, develop a pool of questions or topics that will be discussed or reviewed.
- 2. Seat students in concentric circles (inside circle of students are facing students in the outer circle). See diagram above.
- 3. Present the first question or topic of discussion/review.
- 4. Allow students facing each other 1-2 minutes to discuss question or present information. Call time.
- 5. Instruct the inside circle of students to rotate one person to the right, so that everyone is facing a new partner.
- 6. Present the second question or topic of discussion. Continue the process until all questions or topics have been discussed.
- 7. You may utilize the Stopwatch tool <u>http://www.online-stopwatch.com/</u> to assist in keeping track of time.
